Discrimination suit settled

The Fred Beans family of car dealerships has settled a lawsuit filed by a former employee who claims she was fired because she

was pregnant.
The Plumstead-based company agreed to a \$150,000 judgment in favor of Cherie Santai, a Perkasie woman who worked at
